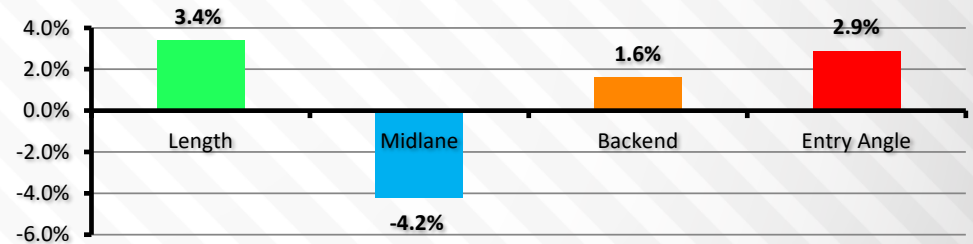

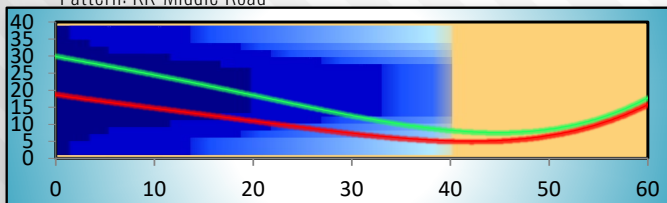

- The Marvel Maxx Elite setback was over 10 boards inside.
- NRG Solid was notably earlier reading than NRG Smooth Pearl.
- The Centripetal Core was strong and even rolling for both balls.
- Both balls complemented each other exceptionally well.
